Rules & Information:



- Students cannot drop-in to specific instrument music classes (7+ Mondays, 8+ on Wednesdays). Fees for these classes must be purchased in 8 week sessions.
- Classes may reach capacity or be subject to cancellation due to low enrollment.
- Priority will be given to the earliest registrations for classes over capacity.
- Additional classes may be added if enough students are on a waiting list.
- There are no drop-in rates for Monday classes.
- Parents may only leave the premises if their child is age 5 or above, sign a leave form, and sign in and out each week.
- Kroc Center staff cannot help students use restrooms or change attire.
- No outside food or drinks are allowed.
- Students may enroll in the next age level only if their birthday is before October 1st.
- No refunds or credits will be given for missed classes.
- Instruments are available for students to use & practice if needed. Some instruments may be available to rent for a fee. Call 228-374-9109 for info.

Class Information

Art allows students to experiment with different types of media, create their own projects, learn art history, and study different artists.

Please bring an apron or wear clothes suitable for all artistic adventures.

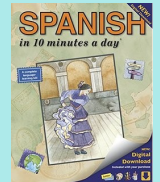
Dance Island School of Performing Arts presents eight week dance sessions focusing on ballet. These dance classes will be ballet based with age appropriate choreography, correct technique, and a joyful atmosphere. ISPA's ballet classes are patterned after the Royal Academy of Dance. ISPA is looking forward to sharing their love of dance with your child and a performance will be held at the end of the semester.

Dancers will need to purchase: A solid black leotard, pink dance tights, pink ballet slippers, and have their hair in a bun. All items can be purchased at Backstage Boutique in Gulfport.

Physical Education teaches students teamwork, exercises, and how to be health conscious while having fun in sport and recreational settings. *Students must wear tennis shoes and athletic attire to participate.*

Science Lab will allow student to perform concentrated science experiments in a group setting. *Please bring an apron or wear clothes suitable for all scientific adventures.*

Spanish teaches students the fundamentals of the Spanish language while learning about Spanish speaking cultures. *Students enrolled in Spanish will need to purchase the book **Spanish in 10 Minutes a Day.***



Swim involves a water safety course followed by team games designed to teach students water safety, respect for pool rules, and have fun in a recreational setting.

Please bring a towel and proper swim attire. In observance of The Salvation Army Church, clothing or cover ups should be worn outside of the Aquatic's area.

Monday Music for ages 3-6 will allow students to explore instruments, play as a group, and build a solid music foundation. Students 7 and up can choose to attend one specialized group music class from **CHOIR, PIANO, or STRINGS** (violin, viola, cello). *Students are expected to attend music classes weekly. Students enrolled in Choir will not need to purchase a book.*

Wednesday Music for ages 4-5 & 6-7 will allow students to explore instruments, play as a group, and build a solid music foundation. Students 8 and up can choose to attend one specialized group music class from **BAND, DRUMS, GUITAR, or KEYBOARD.**

Students enrolled in Piano Class I & II will need to purchase John Thompson's Teaching Little Fingers to Play.

Students in Piano classes II & III will need to purchase John Thompson's Modern Course for the Piano First Grade Book.

Students enrolled in the Band, Drums, Guitar, or Strings class will need to purchase Essential Elements Book 1 (for your specific instrument).
