All class rates are fixed and non-refundable after the first week of Homeschool courses, and the \$10 registration fee is nonrefundable after paid. The deadline to register is also cut off after the first week of courses commences. Any refunds requested will be issued on a Kroc Center gift card to be redeemed in another area of interest. By signing this registration form and enrolling in the program the individual agrees to all these terms & conditions.

Rules and Information

Art Classes – Students may be required to bring supplies to class and will be informed of such supplies by the instructor. Please do not wear clothing that you would want to get dirty or ruined as we often use paints and other materials that can stain clothing. Children may bring their own apron or smock to protect clothing, but they are not provided by the Kroc Center. Students may be given homework to further their art studies!

Music – Students who participate in the specialized music classes (8+) are expected to be in class each week to keep the class moving forward in preparation for their performance(s). Students who miss three or more classes will need to enroll in private lessons to continue in music classes to continue learning at the same rate as the class. It is highly recommended that students rent or purchase their instruments from a local music store, or when available, from the Kroc Center Inventory. Students will be informed by teachers which books and/or supplies they may need to purchase.

All music class participants will be asked to perform at the Spring Recital that will be held on May 25th.

Physical Education – Please bring the following: positive attitude, athletic shoes, athletic clothing (appropriate for the weather), and necessary medications to treat your child in case of emergency.

Spanish – Students age 8 and up will need to purchase the book *Spanish in 10 minutes a day* which can be found online at amazon.com or barnesandnoble.com. Ages 7 and under will be given materials by the instructor.

Swim

1. You must have on shoes and shirts when entering other areas of the facility.
2. The pool at times may be closed due to unforeseeable circumstance. Please be respectful of the situation and staff as they work to keep the pool safe for everyone.
3. **You must be 48 inches to use the slide; this rule will be enforced by staff and lifeguards.**
4. Lifeguards will enforce the following rules: No running on the pool deck, no diving or doing flips off the side of the pool, and no food or drink (except water) on the pool deck.

5. **The correct swimming attire is required. Cotton shirts or shorts are NOT permissible in the pool.**

Other –

- **If you plan on leaving the premises you must fill out a waiver form with an active phone number. You must sign out with the front desk before you leave. Children must be picked up on time or a \$5 fee will be charged for every 10 minutes.**
- No outside food or drinks are allowed at the Kroc Center except bottles of water.
- The first half of your payment must be submitted by January 9th and the last payment for Springs semester is March 18th. **No late payments will be accepted.**
- Parents must come inside the Kroc Center to sign their children into and out of the program.

DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES

The following is a list of disciplinary procedures for homeschool students. They are modified according to the severity of the offensive behavior and the age of the child. The purpose of each action is to bring about a change of behavior and is **not simply punitive in nature**. These actions are devised and applied to discourage continuation of unacceptable conduct. All procedures may not be appropriate to use with every child. While they are listed below in an order of severity this does not state nor imply that they will be used in this order. Certain behavior may require serious disciplinary action such as suspension or expulsion on the first offense. Disciplinary action is handled on a case by case basis, as some actions may not fit the solutions listed below.

1. Warning – Student is issued a verbal warning, parents and/or guardians may be contacted as well.
2. Written warning – Student receives a written letter citing the incident details and action to follow, and a letter is kept on file. Parents are contacted regarding incident.
3. Parent teacher conference – Student and parents will meet with the effected party and the Music and Creative Arts Coordinator.
4. Disciplinary hearing - A meeting will be held between the Director, Coordinator and the student and their family to decide the next appropriate step.

Disciplinary action depends on the teacher or offended parties reporting of an incident worthy of discipline. No teacher or parent of another student is permitted to discipline any child, all incidents must be reported to the Music and Creative Arts Coordinator immediately.

By signing this Program Enrollment Form, I (we) agree to the following: program enrollee will always abide by the terms of this agreement during the period of the program enrollment and will comply with all rules and regulations posted or otherwise communicated to enrollee. The Salvation Army Kroc Center reserves the right to remove from the facility or terminate the enrollment of any program enrollee who fails to comply with any posted rules and regulations or otherwise breaches the terms of this agreement, in which case the program enrollee will not be entitled to a refund of dues.
